#### Cinnamon Stick Tree Ornament

### supplies

- Large cinnamon stick
- Large button
- Twine
- Hot Glue
- (15) Strips of fabric
- Starch (optional)

#### tools

- Scissors-fabric and paper
- Hot glue gun

#### instructions

Cut (15) or more/less fabric strips about 8 1/2" long and about 1" wide using your pinking shears.





Cut the twine about 10" long for the hanging loop, and set it aside.



#### Cinnamon Stick Tree Ornament

Decide the order you want your fabric strips to be and then tie all (15) strips to the cinnamon stick. Slide them up so you have a small piece of cinnamon stick on the top.





Using your hot glue gun add your loop of twine and your button to the top of your tree, I like to sandwich the twine between the button and the cinnamon stick.

Trim the bottom of your cinnamon stick to the length that you like.





#### Cinnamon Stick Tree Ornament

You can use starch at this step if you want a more stiff fabric/tree, it is optional.

Trim the edges of the fabric strips to create a "tree" shape.
