supplies

To make (1) placemat:

- Front fabric-13" x 18"
- Back fabric-13" x 18"
- Pocket fabric-5" x 12"
- Batting

tools

- Sewing Machine
- Pins
- Iron
- Ironing board/mat
- Fabric scissors or rotary cutter and mat

instructions

- 1 Cut your fabric pieces and batting pieces.
- Layer the batting, front piece, and back piece, with the right sides facing each other.







Take the 3 layers and sew all the way around using a 1/2" seam allowance, leaving a 4"-5" opening at the bottom. Backstitch at the beginning and end.





Trim the corners and the edges to remove any excess fabric. This will help with the bulk in the corners.

Turn your placemat right side out, going between the front and back fabrics to turn.





Push out all of the corners and flatten the seams. Using an iron will help with this.

Tuck the raw edges of the opening inside and press.





Using a 1/4" seam allowance topstitch around the placemat making sure to close the opening as you go.

To make your pocket fold your 5" x 12" fabric and sew on the raw edges of the right and left sides, leaving an opening at the bottom about 2"-3" wide.





Turn your pocket right side out and fold in the raw edges of the opening. Topstitch on the folded edge. This will be the top of your pocket.



Measure 1 1/2" from the right side of the placemat and 1 1/2" from the bottom and pin your pocket in place. Sew the pocket on the left, bottom, and right sides.
