- Markers-I like to pick 2 or 3 colors that go together.


- 1 Start by folding your paper, and cut if necessary. Using an 8.5 x 11" sheet of cardstock, you can make 2 smaller cards or one larger one. You can also play around with the orientation of the card and how you want it to open.
- 2 Draw overlapping hearts with your pencil on the front of your card, it might be helpful to practice a few hearts on a scrap piece of paper.

Once you have the hearts on your card how you like them, erase where the lines overlap so some hearts are behind other ones.





Trace the outline of the hearts with a sharpie.


Choose the markers you like and start to doodle/color inside the hearts with the markers. I like to use different patterns on each of them.
